

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

June 24, 2009, 9:00 a.m.

Corner Meeting House

Chairman Ronald Cormier called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.; also present were Selectman Jon Pike, Selectman David Morse, Town Administrator K. Jeanne Beaudin, Administrative Assistant Cary Lagace, Public Works Director Jim Fortin. CDBG Grant Administrator Donna Lane joined the meeting at 9:20 am. Also joining the meeting via teleconference were Aaron Lachance and Rene LaBranche of Stantec Engineering.

Employee Promotion

Chairman Cormier discussed the recently posted Highway Foreman position, stating that the promoting of Mr. Patten to the position does not violate any details of the education requirement in the job description or ad for the position. The verbiage of equivalent of high school diploma can be met with experience or other factors. The Board agreed that they want the right person for the job and they want to move ahead with the promotion.

Selectman Pike moved to promote Claude Patten to Highway Foreman at grade 14 step 2 \$35,820 effective June 29, 2009. Selectman Morse seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Vinyl Siding Town Hall

Town Administrator Beaudin advised that the quoted price for vinyl siding for Town Hall of \$20,200 plus \$900 for painting is firm and can be completed by Old Home Day.

Selectman Pike moved to accept the bid of \$20,200 for the siding of Town Hall plus \$900 to paint the portions that need painting. Chairman Cormier seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Veteran Credit Request

Administrative Assistant Cary Lagace reviewed with the Board a request for a veteran's credit for an individual that has met all the requirements but because he has reenlisted numerous times has not yet received the DD214 form required by the state as a factor to

qualify. He has provided all enlistment certificates that state honorable discharge with reenlistment, he has served two terms in Iraq and has earned the Global War on Terrorism medal, and the Expeditionary medal; all conditions of the Veteran Credit, the only thing he doesn't have is the DD214 document because he has reenlisted 3 times and is still active duty. The Board agreed that he should be granted the veterans credit and if there are veterans in the future that meet these same conditions they too should be granted the veteran credit.

Chairman Cormier called the non-public session to order at 9:15 a.m. in accordance with RSA 91-A:3 II (c). Roll call was taken and those present and voting were Ronald Cormier, Jon Pike and David Morse. Also present was Town Administrator Beaudin, Public Works Director Jim Fortin, CDBG Grant Administrator Donna Lane and Aaron Lachance and Rene LaBranche of Stantec Engineering (present via teleconference) . No decisions were made during non-public session.
