May 3, 2006
Belmont Corner Meeting House

The Education Committee meeting was held at the Belmont Corner Meeting House at 6:00PM, prior to the full BCC monthly meeting. Present were Ginger Wells-Kay, Ed. Committee Chair, and Ken Knowlton, BCC Chairman.

Discussion focused on reviewing the community education goals set out in the New England Grassroots Environmental Fund grant document, for which the BCC was awarding \$1000.00 in a matching grant. The goal the Education Committee decided to focus on over the next 3 months is the first BCC newsletter going out to all Belmont households and introducing the BCC, its functions, and current conservation issues pertinent to Belmont residents.

Both members agreed to work on newsletter article drafts for the June meeting. Topics to be included in the newsletter were discussed. A newsletter draft will then be prepared for the entire BCC to review.

The meeting ended at 6:45PM when the members joined the Open Space Committee to exchange information on what the committees had been discussing.
