Meeting Minutes

April 13, 2006, 3:00 p.m.

Corner Meeting House

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ronald Cormier. Also present were George Condodemetraky, Ron Mitchell, Town Administrator Jeanne Beaudin, Police Chief Vincent Baiocchetti, Elson Moody, Pleasant Oberhausen, Melanie Nelson of the Citizen and a reporter from the Winnisquam Echo.

Chairman Cormier opened the meeting by reviewing the Purpose Statement established by the Board of Selectmen. He explained the Board's stance on renovations to the existing Town Hall Building and also discussed the possibility of eliminating the Mill building from consideration due to mortgage constraints and long term lease agreements.

The Committee also discussed the data collected by the previous Building Committee, and the anticipated space needs for the Police Department. Chief Baiocchetti will contact area departments that are presently considering new stations for their preliminary floor plans.

Discussion continued relative to space needs for both the Town Hall and Police Station. The Committee also discussed the status of the roof at Town Hall. George inquired if the report had included any information on the beam structures; Town Administrator Beaudin will research Town Hall files to see if the info is available.

The Committee adjourned and visited the second floor of the existing Town Hall. The Committee agreed to meet next on Thursday, April 27th, at 4:30 p.m.
