

## **Town Hall Study Committee Minutes July 10 2003**

Present: Ken Knowlton, Linda Frawley, Jeff Marden, David Morse and Candance Daigle

Ken Knowlton began the meeting at 7:00 pm. The meeting would be short in duration because the meeting had been rescheduled from its original date of June 26<sup>th</sup> and there may have been some confusion by other members not in attendance.

Ken Knowlton, Linda Frawley and David Morse reviewed their meeting with Jeff Taylor. Mr. Taylor indicated it was very unlikely that Belmont would be able to get another charrette since one was done ten years ago and many other towns are in demand for them. Mr. Taylor was valuable by highlighting three things the committee should do. The first was get a structural analysis of the current town hall. Second, review other town hall facilities similar to Belmont along with facilities of towns with populations that Belmont expects to have in twenty years. Finally, he stressed local resident involvement.

Ken Knowlton expressed a desire to get a build out analysis done. Ken felt it was essential to know where Belmont will be in twenty years and how that will impact town hall facilities.

The committee in attendance decided to schedule a walk through of the second floor of town hall.

The next meeting is at the Belmont Public Library on August 7, 2003 at 7:00 pm. The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:20 pm.
