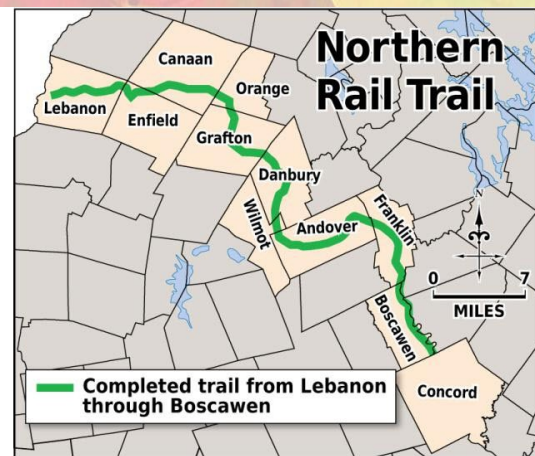


Winni Trail Update Meeting on October 23rd

Continuing progress on the Lake Winnisquam Scenic Trail will be the focus of a Belmont Recreation and Alternative Transportation Team (BRATT) meeting on Oct. 23rd at 7 pm in the Corner Meeting House. With environmental reviews completed, our next steps are to complete trail easements and finalize construction details. The public is invited and encouraged to attend and learn more about the trail. The current schedule is to advertise for construction bids in December 2014 with trail construction next spring 2015 with the trail ready to use in the summer.

The Winni Trail will join with the WOW Trail project in Laconia (Phase 2 scheduled to open next summer), and the Winnepesaukee River Trail in Tilton, Northfield and Franklin to form the Winnepesaukee Rail Trail (WRT) and connect to the recently completed Northern Granite State Rail Trail. The goal for the WRT is to eventually connect Meredith village to the Northern. These trails contribute to the quality of life and Granite State economy by providing recreation and transportation opportunities for residents and visitors. They help make Belknap County a great place to live and visit.
