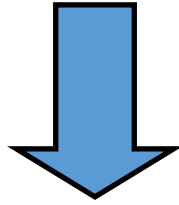

**Town Meeting Update**

There has been a great deal of press surrounding the decision by a number of Towns across the State to postpone their town meetings this past March due to the weather. As a result legislation has been prepared by the Senate that would provide a process for the Governing Board of each of these communities to "ratify" the votes taken. The Town of Belmont once the bill is signed into law by the Governor will be holding a public hearing for this purpose only to comply with the legislation. It is the Town's position and that of our legal counsel that our Moderator was well within his authority to postpone our meeting to insure the safety of our residents in light of the storm. We will keep you posted.
