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Do you wish to adopt an Environmental Conditions Map that identifies four types of land classification?

1. **Land not to be developed.**
 - **Aquifers, floodplains, wetlands (including hydric soils), and stream courses including setbacks, deeryards, significant wildlife habitat and corridors, slopes over 25%, and ridgelines and hilltops, town forests and protected land.**
2. **Marginally developable land**
 - **Land of moderate resource value comprising of agricultural soils of state importance and slopes between 15% and 25%.**
3. **Developable Land**
 - **Land that is not subject to the above environmental constraints.**
4. **Developed Land**
 - **Landowners fully presumed to have fully exercised the development rights of their properties.**
