# HISTORIC BELMONT BANDSTAND

Sunday, September 28, 2014 at 1:30 p.m.

Join members of local, state and preservation communities in saluting the restoration of the historic Belmont Bandstand this Sunday. The family-friendly event features combined choruses of the *Canterbury Elementary* and *Belmont Middle Schools*, cider, apples, and cookies baked by students from the *Lakes Region Community College Culinary Arts Program*.

LCHIP (*Land and Community Heritage Investment Program*) provided a matching grant last year, supporting repainting the structure in its original Victorian-era colors and its second roof replacement since 1908.
